

Fly-In to Victory Day

A Celebration of the End of World War II in Europe

April 9, Chantilly, VA - In your Air Show Forecast for April-May, I note that you did not list this WWII Smithsonian event.

This will include the largest ever formational flyover of World War II aircraft, in battle sequence as noted below. There will be a very large gathering of WWII Vets at the WWII memorial in honor of the 70th anniversary of Victory in Europe (VE) Day.

The flyover will include dozens of World War II aircraft flying in 15 historically sequenced warbird formations overhead. The formations will represent the War's major battles, from Pearl Harbor through the final air assault on Japan, and concluding with a missing man formation to "Taps." Never before has such a collection of WWII aircraft been assembled at one location, to honor the large assemblage of veterans gathered at the WWII Memorial for a ceremony.
